

HONOR FLIGHT Brought to Duchesne Via Senior Capstone Project

Emily Noonan '19, a member of Duchesne's Scholars Academy, has chosen to bring the Greater St. Louis Honor Flight to our Duchesne community.

The mission of the Honor Flight Network is to fly America's veterans to Washington, D.C. at no cost to them to visit the memorials which honor their sacrifices. Top priority is given to America's most senior veterans and any terminally ill veterans who wish to visit their memorial.

Veterans of World War II, the Korean War, and the Vietnam War are eligible candidates.

"In bringing this project to Duchesne, I hope to honor our

alumni by building awareness, and help past Duchesne students who served in these wars register with Honor Flight," Emily said. "I plan to work with my schoolmates to raise the funds needed to send our veterans on an Honor Flight and establish the Honor Flight program here at Duchesne so that the process and program will continue between our alumni veterans and our current students after I graduate."

The morning featured period demonstrations performed by students from the Academy of the Sacred Heart, information and a display from a local Potawatomi citizen, and speeches from several Missouri and St. Charles dignitaries. The celebration culminated with a short play performed by Duchesne High School and Academy of the Sacred Heart students which reenacted Philippine's journey and arrival in St. Charles.

Those in attendance also enjoyed a photo op with "flat Philippine" in front of a life-size replica of the Duquette Mansion, the original building of the Academy of the Sacred Heart.

THE DUCHESNE House system Makes its debut

Why a House System?

The House System helps to more effectively fulfill the mission of Duchesne on a daily basis by:

- fostering leadership skills
- expanding our mentorship program
- increasing **service** participation
- building a stronger sense of community

The House System makes the transition to high school easier by providing a sense of belonging in a small community across all levels, interests, and activities.

Structure

Duchesne's houses are named for North American saints and are each comprised of four mixed grade-level groups with faculty and staff advisers. Each house has two student captains, a male and a female. The officers are four additional students, three of which represent an area of the Duchesne mission and one responsible for the spirituality of the house: *mind, body, spirit, and soul.*

Points are awarded for a variety of different competitions; these events are based on *mind, body, and spirit.* Houses compete for the **"House Cup,"** which is awarded at the end of each school year.


