

eLearning Day

Student Information

The purpose of an eLearning Day is to provide students with a day of learning that may supplement what would happen in a regular classroom setting but allow them to not have to travel to school if there is inclement weather.

General Information:

- The best time for the school to use an eLearning Day would be when there is a forecast of inclement weather and therefore some advanced warning.
 - The faculty and students will be notified the day before, while at school, that there will be an eLearning day.
- There may be some classes that do not warrant themselves to having an online or at home assignment (Weightlifting, Drawing II, STEM). The required work for these courses needs be evaluated on a case by case basis.

Overview:

- Follow the half-day schedule for the appropriately scheduled “Day”
 - If this falls on a Late Start day, classes will still begin at 7:45
- Teacher will take attendance at the start of class in Schoology
 - It does not matter what type of class or what assignment is scheduled
 - Study Hall students need to check in with the teacher for attendance

Attendance:

- Attendance is taken for every class, including Study Halls, PE, Art, Music, etc.

 - Teachers will be given the list of students who were not able to access the internet on the day of the eLearning day the next school day.
 - Teachers will discuss with those students who do not have the internet available on how to make-up their work when school returns
